The award is inspired by UCEA's core mission to advance the preparation and practice of educational leaders for the benefit of all children and schools, and the recipient(s) will be given a significant cash award. Awards given at the UCEA Convention

Nominations for each of the following are due on June 3, 2019

Edwin M. Bridges Award is given by UCEA annually for original, outstanding work in the area of research and/or development that contributes to our knowledge and understanding of how best to prepare and support future generations of educational leaders.

Roald F. Campbell Award is given to senior professor in recognition of his or her lifetime of excellent achievement.

Jack A. Culbertson Award is given to a professor in the first six years of his or her career for an outstanding scholarly accomplishment or contribution.

Master Professor Award, given to an individual faculty member whose distinguished record warrants recognition by UCEA in a significant and timely manner.

Jay D. Scribner Mentoring Award is given to a educational leadership faculty who has made substantive contributions to the field through mentoring the next generation of scholars into roles as university research professors, while also recognizing the important role(s) mentors play in supporting and advising junior faculty.

The GSS will commence at 12:00pm on Wednesday, November 20, 2019 and conclude at 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, November 21, 2019. The purpose of the GSS is to provide graduate students a space to engage in authentic dialogue about their scholarly work. This GSS will offer opportunities to meet and network with graduate students and faculty, to present your work, and receive feedback on your research.

Graduate students engaged in research, policy, or practice in educational or youth-serving agencies may submit proposals for consideration. Proposals must be received by Monday, May 5, 2019 11:59 pm Eastern Standard Time. 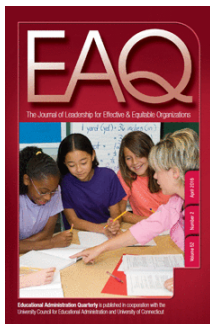

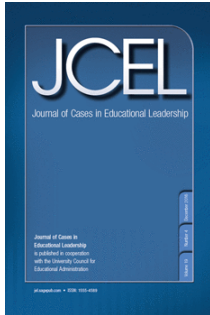
