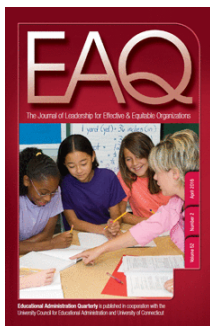
## Call for William L. Boyd National Educational Politics Workshop

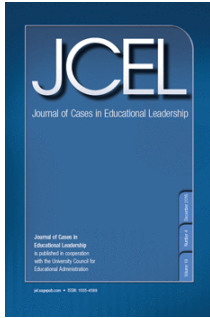
